Geographic distribution: Lyme disease is prevalent in the tri-state area.



Lyme Disease is transmitted to humans by the bite of infected *Ixodes scapularis* (blacklegged tick or deer tick).



White-tailed Deer (*Odocoileus virginianus*) is an important link in the life-cycle of the *Ixodes scapularis*.



Tick identification.



Neurological disorders.



Lyme disease treatment: Penicillin V potassium.



Prevention: Physical barriers (Use duct tape to seal pants cuffs to boots).



Prevention: Remove the tick using pointed tweezers. Other methods to remove ticks, such as using a hot match, are not advised.
