NUMERICAL REFERENCE FOR THE MYCENAEAN IDEOGRAMS

Dr. Bennett and I have now come to agreement on a numerical reference for the Mycenaean ideograms, to meet the need discussed by Sterling Dow¹ and in my «Suggested code of practice»².

The proposed scheme is incorporated in Tables I to III, copied from two tables drawn for a forthcoming book in collaboration with John Chadwick (for the ideograms of vessels see that book, chapter 10, fig. 16).³ It is of course only the reference *numbering* of the ideograms which we should like to see standardized: their meanings and forms still require much further discussion, and those entered here only represent our own analysis.

The ideograms are divided into functional groups corresponding to the break-down in Bennett's *Index*, pp. 107-117; and these groups have been numbered beginning 100, 110, 120 etc., with some provision of spare numbers for future additions.

It will be seen that the «phonetic signs used as ideograms» are not given separate numbers but references in Bennett's order of the syllabary, as numbered by Dow and since generally accepted.
